

**ACHT UM THEANGACHA OIFIGIÚLA,
2003**
Aighneachtaí á Lorg

Tá an tSeirbhís Chúirteanna i mbun athbhreithniú a dhéanamh ar a scéim teanga de réir Alt 15 d'Acht na dTeangacha Oifigiúla, 2003 agus dréachtscéim nua a ullmhú. Is í príomhchuspóir an Acharta ná a dheimhniú go n-ardaítear an soláthar seirbhísí poiblí trí mheán na Gaeilge agus go n-ardaítear caighdeán na seirbhísí sin.

Bunaíodh an tSeirbhís Chúirteanna mar ghníomhaireacht neamhspleách ar an 9 Samhain 1999 i ndiaidh achtú an Acharta um Sheirbhís Chúirteanna, 1998. Is iad na feidhmeanna atá ag an tSeirbhís ná:

- na cúnaitheanna a bhainistiú
- seirbhísí tacaíochta a sholáthar do na breithiúna
- faisnéis a chur ar fáil don phobal maidir leis an gcóras cúnaitheanna
- foirgnimh chúirte a sholáthar, a bhainistiú agus a chothabháil, agus
- saoráidí a sholáthar d'úsáideoirí na gcúnaitheanna
- cibé feidhmeanna eile a thugtar dó le haon achtachán eile a chomhlíonadh.

Leis seo, tá an tSeirbhís Chúirteanna ag iarraidh ar na daoine sin a úsáideann ár seirbhísí aighneachtaí a chur isteach maidir leis an athbhreithniú atáthar chun déanamh ar an [scéim reatha](#). Níor chóir níos mó ná 4,000 focal a bheith sna haighneachtaí [timpeall 8 leathanach ar fad]. Request for Submissions

The Courts Service is reviewing its language scheme in accordance with section 15 of the Official Languages Act 2003 and preparing a new draft scheme. The primary purpose of the Act is to ensure better availability and a higher standard of public services through Irish.

The Courts Service was established as an independent corporate body on 9 November 1999 following the enactment of the Courts Service Act 1998. Its functions are:

- to manage the courts;
- to provide support services for the judges;
- to provide information on the courts system to the public;
- to provide, manage and maintain court buildings;
- to provide facilities for users of the courts;
- to perform such other functions as are conferred on it by any other enactment.

The Courts Service invites those who use our services to make submissions in relation to the review of its [current scheme](#). Submissions should not exceed 4,000 words [c.8 pages]. The latest date for receipt of submissions is 5 p.m. on 31 st day of July 2020.
