### PREPARATION OF ITS SECOND LANGUAGE SCHEME BY DUBLIN AND DÚN LAOGHAIRE EDUCATION AND TRAINING BOARD (DDLETB)

Dublin and Dún Laoghaire Education and Training Board proposes to draft a scheme in accordance with Section 11 of the Official Languages Act 2003. The primary objective of the Act is to ensure better availability and a higher standard of public services through Irish. Dublin and Dún Laoghaire Education and Training Board now wishes to invite representations in relation to the preparation of the draft scheme from any interested parties.
