2023 FUNDING FOR CONSERVATION WORKS TO PROTECTED STRUCTURES OR STRUCTURES WITHIN ARCHITECTURAL CONSERVATION AREAS

Fingal County Council is inviting applications for the following schemes for small, medium or large scale repairs or conservation projects to Protected Structures and in certain circumstances to buildings that enhance Architectural Conservation Areas within the Fingal area.

- Architectural Heritage Fund's "Stitch in Time Grant" 2023 (funding €100 to €2,500)
- Built Heritage Investment Scheme 2023 (funding €2,500 to €15,000)
- Historic Structures Fund 2023
 - Stream 1 (funding €15,00 to €50,000)
 - Stream 1 Historic Shopfronts Sub-stream (funding €15,00 to €50,000)
 - Stream 2 (funding €50,000 to €200,000)
 - Vernacular Structures Stream (funding €5,000 to €10,000)
