<p><b>Cúlra</b></p> <p><b>Bhunaigh Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe scéim scoláireachtaí (Coláistí Samhraidh Gaeltachta) in 2016, chun aitheantas a thabhairt maidir leis an dlúthbhaint a bhí ag Pádraig Mac Piarais le Contae na Gaillimhe. B'oidoir tiomanta é Pádraig Mac Piarais agus bhunaigh sé scoileanna i mBaile Átha Cliath agus i nGaillimh. Is minic a thug sé daltaí go Conamara chun Gaeilge a fhoghlaim.</b></p> <p><b><u>Sonraí na Scéime</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Cuimsíonn an scéim 14 scoláireacht (ag brath ar éileamh agus ar an soláthar) – beidh leath de na scoláireachtaí maoinithe ag Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe agus beidh an chuid eile maoinithe go caoithiúil idir an gComhairle Chontae agus na Coláistí Gaeltachta, liostaithe ar an bhFoirm Iarratais.</b></li> <li>• <b>Maoineoidh na scoláireachtaí seo freastal na ndaltaí cáilitheacha iarbhunoidéachais ar seacht gColáiste Samhraidh Gaeltachta i gContae na Gaillimhe.</b></li> <li>• <b>Beidh cúig cinn de na scoláireachtaí curtha in áirithe chun deis a thabhairt dóibh siúd a bhféadfadh sé nach mbeadh an deis sin acu freastal ar Chúrsaí Samhraidh Gaeltachta gan scoláireacht dá leithéid. Bronnfar scoláireacht amháin acu seo i ngach ceann de na 5 Cheantar Bardasach atá i gContae na Gaillimhe – Baile Átha an Rí-Órán Mór, Béal Átha na Sluaighe, Conamara, Baile Locha Riach agus Tuaim.</b></li> <li>• <b>Chun cáiliú do na scoláireachtaí seo atá in áirithe, caithfidh an t-iarrthóir díolúine a</b></li> </ul>	<p><b>Background</b></p> <p>A Gaeltacht Summer College scholarship scheme was established by Galway County Council in 2016 in recognition of the strong ties between Pádraig Mac Piarais and the County of Galway.</p> <p>Pádraig Mac Piarais was a committed educator and set up schools both in Dublin and Galway. He often brought Irish students to Conamara in order to learn Irish.</p> <p><b><u>Scheme Details</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The scheme is made up of <b>14 Scholarships</b> (dependent on demand and availability) comprising of – Full Scholarships funded by Galway County Council and also, Scholarships sponsored equally between the Council and the Gaeltacht Colleges listed on the Application Form.</li> <li>• The scholarships will fund the attendance of qualifying second level students at seven Gaeltacht Summer Colleges in the County of Galway.</li> <li>• 5 of the Scholarships will be reserved to afford those who may not otherwise have the opportunity to attend Summer Gaeltacht Courses the opportunity to do so. One of these reserved scholarships will be presented in each of the 5 Municipal Districts of the County of Galway – Athenry-Oranmore, Ballinasloe, Conamara, Loughrea and Tuam.</li> <li>• To qualify for these reserved scholarships the applicant must have received an exemption</li> </ul>

### Coinníollacha na Scéime

- Tá an scéim scoláireachtaí oscailte do dhaltáí dara leibhéal a bhfuil cónaí orthu i gContae na Gaillimhe (níl Cathair na Gaillimhe san áireamh sa scéim).
- Bronnfar 5 Scoláireacht (ceann i ngach Ceantar Bardasach) ar iarrthóirí a ndearbhaíonn a scoil go bhfuil díolúine faighte acu ó tháillí an Teastais Shóisearaigh san am atá caite.
- Caithfidh iarrthóirí a mbronntar scoláireachtaí orthu éarlais in-aisíoctha de €100 a íoc leis an gColáiste Gaeltachta atá i gceist, éarlais a aisíocfar ar chríochnú sásúil an chúrsa.
- Déanfar cinneadh maidir le scoláireachtaí trí tharraingt oscailte d'iarrthóirí incháilithe.
- Mura bhfuil sé indéanta scoláireacht a ofráil do rogha coláiste an iarrthóra rathúil, ofrálfar an chéad rogha eile is airde atá ar fáil.
- Mura bhfuil rogha leantach léirithe/ ar fáil ní bheifear in ann an t-iarratas a mheas chun coláistí eile a ofráil.
- Is do chúrsaí **mhí Lúnasa 2024 amháin (tosaíonn cúrsa mhí Lúnasa ag deireadh mhí Iúil)** iad na scoláireachtaí seachas má tá **áit curtha in áirithe go neamhspleách ag iarrthóir rathúil ag coláiste do chúrsa mhí an Mheithimh/Iúil 2024** agus go dtagann sé sin le torthaí na tarraingthe.

### Scheme Conditions

- The scholarship scheme is open to second level students resident in the County of Galway (excluding Galway City).
- 5 Scholarships (one in each municipal district) will be presented to applicants whose School confirms that they were exempted Junior Certificate state exams fees in the past.
- Successful scholarship recipients must pay a refundable deposit of €100 to the Gaeltacht College in question which will be repaid on the satisfactory completion of the course.
- Scholarships will be decided by an open draw of qualifying candidates.
- If it is not possible to offer a scholarship for the successful applicants preferred college, the next highest available preference will be offered.
- If a following preference is not indicated/ available, it will not be possible to consider the application for offer in other colleges.
- The Scholarships are for the the **August 2024 course only (August Course commences at the end of July)** unless a successful applicant has already **reserved a place at a college for the June/July 2024 course** and that matches the outcome of the draw.
